Repurpose

During the development of Stationers' Hall materials were repurposed and reused including:

- York Stone Unearthed in construction phase reused for garden pathing
- Wooden flooring taken up and recycled in new link corridor
- Doors repurposed in different rooms instead of buying new.



Low Energy Lighting

Low energy lighting used throughout the venue including proximity-activated lighting in bathrooms and public areas



Water Conservation

Water conservation is being achieved by reducing water usage through the installation of low flowing taps and toilets.
